Regulation Statement

The Texas A&M University System (system) strives to manage, control and, where appropriate, reduce or eliminate risk to its employees, students and visitors, its financial condition, and its material and natural resources. Supplemental risk management standards support this goal by establishing agreed practices that exceed or expand upon system policy and state and federal statutes and regulations.

Reason for Regulation

While system members are responsible for being in compliance with System Policy 24.01, *Risk Management*, and with state and federal risk management rules and statutes, additional standards and administrative procedures that exceed or expand upon these requirements are, from time to time, adopted by the system in order to form a more comprehensive risk management framework.
