

CEU/CPE Credits for System Offices Online Training

Individuals who hold professional licenses or certifications are often required to earn continuing education credits on an annual basis. Depending on the profession, these credits may be referred to as continuing education units (CEUs), continuing professional education (CPE), or various other names. Several of the online courses offered by the System Offices award CEU or CPE credit, as described below.

CEUs are equivalent to 1/10 of the contact hours for training (10 contact hours =1 Continuing Education Unit).

The CPE credits have been approved by System Internal Audit, which is registered as a Continuing Professional Education sponsor with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (sponsor ID #004663). Courses that offer CPE credit can be used by certified public accountants to meet their continuing education requirements. .
