Below are updates on subcontractor bidding opportunities on the A&M System's capital projects.

Flintco has issued an ITB for BP#1 for the Educare Facility project (#25-3402). This package includes the following scopes: SWPPP, Earthwork, Maintenance, Site access, Turnkey concrete, and Utilities, and bids are due on November 15, 2024. Documents are on BuildingConnected. Flintco plans release BP#2 in later this month (November) and anticipates to buy-out scopes from this package

Paragon Sports is accepting bids for Early Release Package for the Multipurpose Field/Track/Softball Field project (#25-3421). This package includes the following scopes: SWPPP, General conditions, Electrical, and Earthwork, and bids are due on November 21, 2024. Documents are on ConstructConnect. NTP for this package is anticipated to be December 6, 2024. Paragon tentatively plans to release the main bid package for this project on January 9, 2025 with subcontractor award anticipated on or by January 20,2025, mobilization on or by January, 29, 2025, and substantial completion on or by December 2025. This is a specialty project that is expected to include the following scopes: earthwork, synthetic turf fields, irrigation, landscaping, site concrete/flatwork, athletic field fencing, asphalt, retaining walls, sidewalk power washing, site-clean-up, and parking lot restriping.
