Below are updates on subcontractor bidding opportunities on the A&M System's capital projects.

Flintco plans release BP#2 for the Educare Facility project (#25-3402) this month (November) and anticipates to buy-out scopes from this package by early Q1 2025. Substantial completion is anticipated to be in May 2026. Dates are tentative.
